<u>Football</u>, <u>Fastpitch</u>, <u>Basketball</u>: The practice and game schedules will be posted on the school's web site shortly after each season begins. Practices will be held from 2:20 to 4:00PM at NTMS (Football practice goes to 4:30). Bus transportation is provided to all away games that will be held with the Auburn middle schools. However, parents will need to arrange for transportation home following the games.

<u>Gymnastics</u>: Gymnastics is available through Mt. Baker Middle School in Auburn. Parents must provide transportation to Mt. Baker for gymnastics practices and meets.
